The primary objective was to develop content featuring breeders' own perspectives, specifically through breeder testimonials that articulate their motivations for breeding Ayrshires.

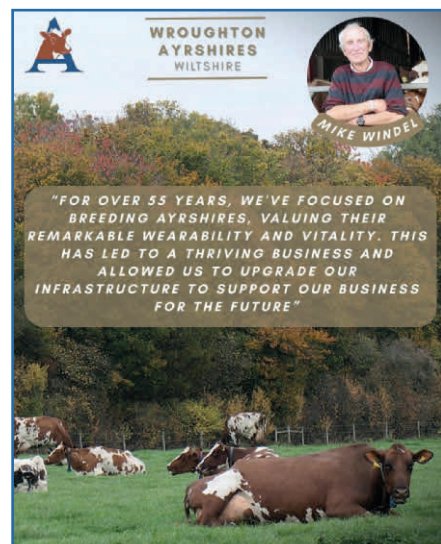
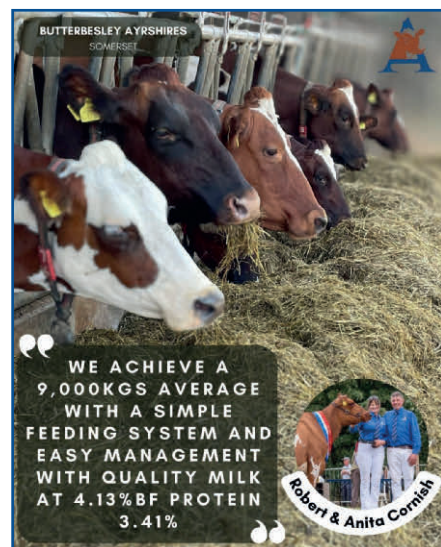

Breed Heritage Report

The program continues to support breed improvement, offering promising opportunities for future generations of families throughout the United Kingdom. This year, female calves because of the BH breeding suggestions have shown notable increases in their predicted Transmitting Abilities (PTAs) for Index, production, and components, with many demonstrating advancements across all three traits.

As an example:

Plaskett Lucky Charm 402

Sired by Tontine Astorwell out of Plaskett Lucky Charm 356 EX91. We have seen a huge increase of production and lifetime index to reach the following:

- PLI £242
- 454Kgs
- Fat 12.9Kgs
- Protein 17.2Kgs

Other females born and registered so far this year from the program are sired by numerous Ayrshire sires including Tontine Astorwell, Troutbeck Daring, Ravenhill Revolver, VR Uppura, Plein Soleil Hacker, Pam Ayr Hawaiian and Palmyra Lochinvar Reynolds.

Genomics remains a significant challenge for the Ayrshire breed in the UK. We are gradually identifying the underlying causes of our difficulties in achieving meaningful reliability. Currently, our knowledge indicates the following:

When reliability is low, breeding values are pulled toward the average - so top animals don't look as good and lower-performing ones don't seem as poor, at least until the animal has daughter proofs or her own performance data when we see them rise or lower back to their original PTAs. The main way to address this is by genotyping increasing numbers of females, which improves the accuracy of genomic tests, but that is difficult when breeders know that their animals will receive unreliable data.

We've also observed that the reference population must be relevant; the original males from the early reference group born before 2009 reduces the reliability of said reference group.

We can try to be optimistic that the genetic improvement project currently being supported

by the World Ayrshire Federation, working with Interbull to assess the feasibility of including Ayrshire females' data in the MACE (Multiple across Countries Evaluation) evaluation so to obtain international EBVs from both males and females expressed in each participating countries' scale of evaluation provides a solution.

We would also like to draw attention to polled genetics for future planning. If any breeders have polled families or individuals, we will be delighted to hear from and work with you to expand on polled options available.

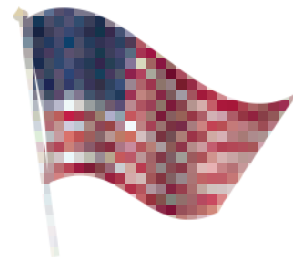

US National Convention in Vermont celebrating 150 years

The US Ayrshire Breeders Association marked its 150th anniversary in July 2025 by organising a convention held in Vermont, USA. Delegates from around the world were invited to attend and participate in the celebrations. Among the international attendees were two breeders and members from the United Kingdom, Peter Berresford and George Oultram, who have subsequently provided additional information in response to our questions.

Please describe the circumstances that led to your participation in this trip to the United States.

George: The Ayrshire Cattle Society contacted me about the possibility of going on an international trip as a reward for winning the Hugh Stevenson competition at the 2024 Ayrshire Young Breeders weekend.

Peter: As one of the UK representatives for the World Ayrshire Federation, I was asked if I would be interested in attending as a guest of the US Ayrshire Breeders Association.

Kindly provide an overview of the convention's purpose and main themes.

George: The convention allows the AABA (American Ayrshire breeders association) to meet and perform their AGM along with the board members having their summer meetings. The convention also allows for the promotion and exploration of local herds whilst on the tour.

Peter: In addition to the AGM, board meetings were held where various subcommittees provided updates on developments within each sector. David Hanson was elected as the new President, succeeding Rhonda Winkler.

Could you specify which herds you visited during your time in the United States and share any notable insights from your observations?

George/Peter: True Blessings Ayrshires, Four Hills Ayrshires, Blue-Spruce farm, Locust Springs, Maple Dell, Vales Pride, Palmyra Farm, South Mountain.

George: All farms had a similar breeding strategy which focussed on efficiency and production whilst also retaining desirable conformation traits, with a view for the show ring.





Peter: It was fascinating to see the unique differences among farms, especially those with mainly other breeds that had recently added Ayrshire bloodlines.

In what ways do you find farms in the USA differ from those in the UK?

George: Farms in the USA tend to be either big or small, for example Blue Spruce farm is over 1500 cows and True Blessings is less than 100. UK farms tend to be more moderately sized around 200-300 cows.

Peter: Grazing herds are rare in the United States, and some dairies stand out for their enormous size. Another trend is the popularity of maintaining a "show string."

How are the breed societies different between our two countries?

George: The AABA regions operate more autonomously than ACS regions due to the overall size of the USA compared to the UK.

Peter: No big differences in my view, however there is much more positivity in the AABA.

Can we in the UK adopt any of their attributes?

George: The UK could be better at promoting at a regional level (within their clubs) but overall, there are processes that the UK does better than the USA.

Peter: We should adapt that positivity and help each other in the way the AABA embraces each state.

What did you consider to be the highlight of your trip?

George: Seeing a cloned milking daughter of the Palmyra Berkely Ruth EX94 cow that dominated the show ring in the late 2010s into the 2020s.

Peter: There were so many highlights: Meeting old friends, putting faces to names of Facebook friends, talking all things Ayrshire, viewing great cows and even attending my first Baseball game!

Would you like to send a message to your US hosts?

George: Thank you for the incredible hospitality and the openness and welcoming of all members, especially the farms that we visited and to Mike and Mary Creek for looking after us for the full duration of the trip. I would also like to thank Breed Heritage for funding the flights over to the convention.

Peter: I'm grateful to so many people. Thank you to everyone at the convention for your warm welcome, to Rhonda Winkler for her limitless generosity, to all our farm hosts, to Mike Creek for his wonderful guidance and companionship during our tour, and to Mary Creek whose tireless efforts made everything possible.



Cow Family Feature – Hilltown Violet

In evaluating the impact of cow families on the Ayrshire breed, it is expected that strong lineages will consistently produce progeny distinguished by elevated production levels, exceptional milk quality, ease of management, and prolonged longevity. The Hilltown Violet family exemplifies these qualities with clarity and consistency.

We invited Mark Nicholls to share the history and characteristics of this renowned cow family, as well as to highlight some of its most outstanding members.

The Origin of the Violets at Hilltown.

The history of the Violet family dates back nearly 70 years to early 1957, when four heifer calves were purchased from Mr. Muir at Garliford Farm, located approximately two miles west of Hilltown. Shortly after these calves arrived at Hilltown, Mr. Muir contacted the Nicholls family to inform them that his prized cow, Violet, had delivered a heifer calf, which he wished to include in the transaction.

An agreement was reached with a unique condition: as the original price for the initial four calves was deemed more than fair, the additional heifer would be provided at no cost. The new calf was collected and taken home in the back of the car. Not long thereafter, the herd at Garliford Farm was dispersed.

Demonstrating the fortune often associated with successful cow families, the Violets have continued to thrive and prosper over the years at Hilltown.

Main Attributes of the Violet family.

The Hilltown Violets are outstanding Ayrshire cattle, well-known for their longevity and distinctive features, such as open ribs, deep wedge-shaped bodies, and broad muzzles. Their tough, dark hooves rarely require trimming and instances of lameness are uncommon. This family exhibit strong bone structure and excellent udders with secure attachments and central ligaments. They reliably transmit their desirable traits regardless of the bull selected for breeding. Additionally, they naturally produce milk high in butterfat and protein, thriving on a straightforward grass diet.

Many members of the Violet family have been sold at draft sales and have subsequently achieved notable success, particularly within prominent herds such as Butterbesley, Bigginvale, Creech Hill, Golden, Greenlane, and Hilcol, among others.

Male Family members born to the Violet Family who have made an impact.

Hilltown Patcheye, Sired by Blackaddar Milk Machine. Sold to Andrew Meikle, Meikle's Ayrshires.

Hilltown Millenium, Sired by Brocklehill Amazing Grace, he produced cattle with dark, clean bone structure. Although not the largest in size, these animals were noted for their exceptional correctness.

Hilltown Bandit Sired by Pant outlaw. We successfully bred several outstanding, robust cattle. The use of Don-Sher Hector proved highly effective, and in hindsight, it would have been beneficial to retain him for a longer period.

Hilltown Masterpiece VG 86 was Sired by Edenvale Frontpiece. He did a good job at Hilltown breeding trouble free, low maintenance cows

Hilltown Optimism VG88, sired by Hilltown Oblique, bred numerous very good hardwearing cows.

Hilltown Harvestime was sired by Halmyre Urr Vice Consul. He was small but mighty, breeding deep functional cows.

Hilltown Glacier EX90. Sired by Woodland View Pardner, a mostly white bull known for his good milk production and type, was sold to a local crossbreeding herd where he served as the main dairy sire for several years, producing a consistent herd.

Hilltown Galaxy EX90 by Roi Galant. A large dairy bull improved both milk yield and conformation in his daughters.

Hilltown Yukon Delta EX90 By La Croisee Yukon. He was sold to Cattle Services Ayr where he is currently producing promising youngstock around the country.

JUDGING SEMINAR - TESSVALE

This year, just one judging seminar was held. In October, more than forty Ayrshire members and guests visited Tessvale Ayrshires near Stoke-on-Trent, thanks to the generosity of Chris and Andrea Adams and their family. Andrea and her helpers treated everyone to an excellent lunch and refreshments, which were greatly enjoyed. Members also toured the Tessvale herd, which demonstrated remarkable consistency and correctness in the milking cows, reflecting Chris Adams' breeding strategy.

The dedication and hospitality shown by Chris, Andrea, their family, and their helpers made the event a resounding success, and all their hard work and enthusiasm were deeply appreciated. We offer our heartfelt thanks for their commitment to an exceptional day.

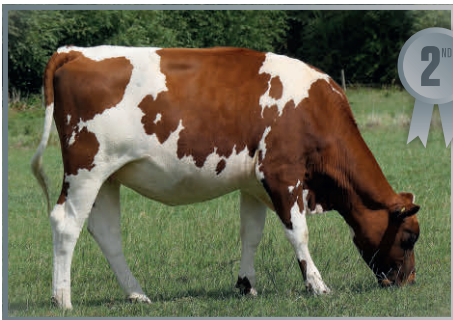

one class topping at 52 entries. The champion heifer went to Bricker-Farms R Cadillac, a stylish Palmyra Lochinvar Reynolds daughter.

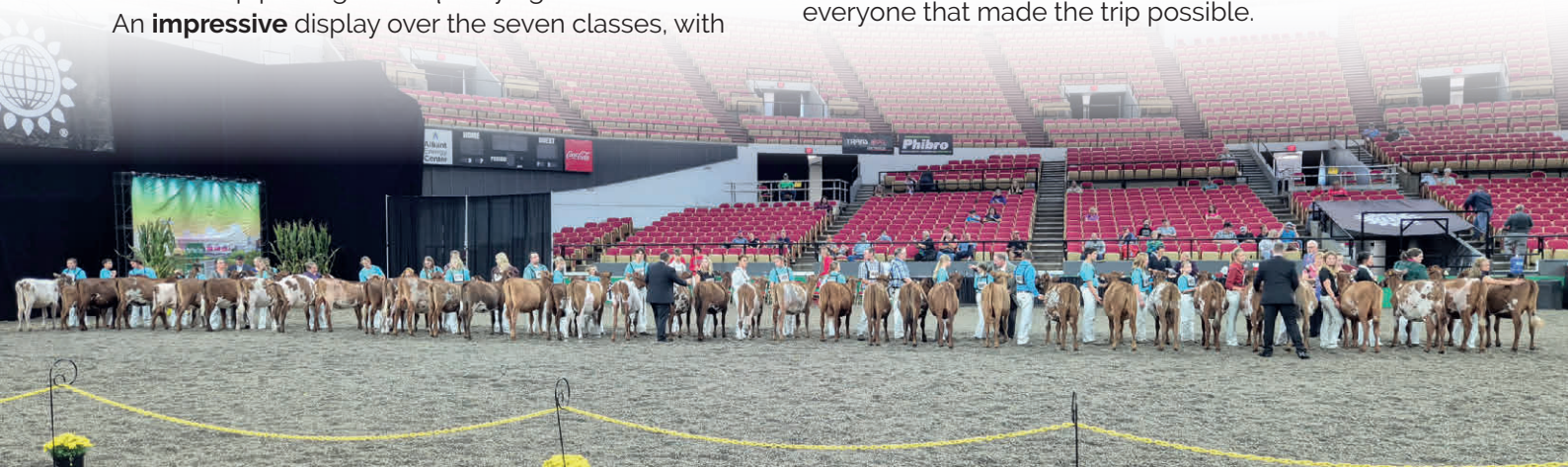
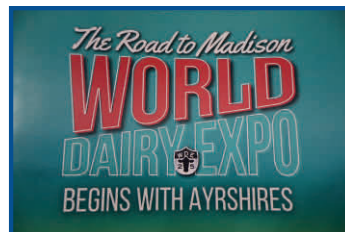
The following day was an early start with the first of the milking classes taking to the ring at 7am. Starting with the milking yearling heifers, you could see that the standard was already going to be high.

Many Years ago, I delivered some Semen to the Jones Family at their Farm just outside Dumfries on the Road to New Abbey, where they kept an unregistered herd of Ayrshires. The gentlemen I met that day was Raymond Jones, a familiar figure at the local shows to the area. Although he hadn't registered the herd, he had a keen interest in his cows and the breed. The day I was there was a fine summers day, and the cows were out in a field grazing. Raymond asked if I would like to go for a walk through them, I readily accepted the invitation and enjoyed an hour looking at a great herd of Ayrshire cows. I recall thinking that they were particularly good of their udders as well as very mobile and very uniformed.

They had an impression on me that lay in the back of my mind and when the herd came to be dispersed many years later, I contacted Kerr who lived at Gretna and asked if he could go to the sale and see if there was anything to purchase.

At that time, we had very little money available for new stock purchases, so Kerr picked out two heifers, the first one was fresh and bloomy, and the other was Queen of the South who was nearer mid lactation and not PD back in calf at that time although she had been served.

The cattle were a flying trade, so the fresh heifer was out of our price range, but Queen of the South was purchased for £1200. Our lack of funds that day had proved a blessing for us, but that knowledge all lay hidden in the future.

On arrival home she came bulling that night, so it was an inauspicious start, she came over another time before she settled to Harperfield Sands of Time.

She calved the week before dairy day with her 2nd the following year, and I recall a conversation with Howard and Linda Batty, and we had a chuckle about how fashions had changed and how we would have convinced Dan Lindsay that she was "too fresh" to go to Telford! She was as he would have said a "humdinger". Fashions have indeed changed but good Ayrshire type hasn't. The way we show them has changed for sure, but the good ones are still good.

As the Jones family had never registered, we tried to trace back to see if there was a family she went back to as they had purchased many good cattle over the years, but her line was entirely home bred for generations.

There had been a family called Queen of the South at Harperfield that had died out many years earlier at No 47, and we had started calling her the Queen of the South (Her Dumfries heritage) so we registered her as Queen of the South 60 and by that we would know she was a new family, that is why she carries the Harperfield Prefix.

She has produced three live heifer calves and one born dead. Her eldest daughter Queen of the South 61 by Sands of time is just finishing her first lactation and has developed into a grand young cow and will hopefully be out in the showing next year. There is then a served heifer by Harperfield Watership Down to calf next spring and her last calf is a full sister.

We are confident enough with this cow and her progeny to date, both on the type and her production (as is her calved daughter) that we will endeavour to retain a son if we get one from her. Her udder conformation is such that it must trace back to something special as udders like hers don't come by fluke, particularly with the production and wearability she is showing. She is now a youthful fifth calver with her 3 recorded lactations (2-4) averaging 8000 kg's.

ORAL REHYDRATION OF THE SCOURING CALF

Dr John Henderson – Large Animal Veterinary Advisor, Forte Healthcare

Scour is the most common cause of death in calves under 2 weeks of age. Several different infectious agents cause diarrhoea and the severity of the condition can vary from mild, where the calf recovers uneventfully in a couple of days, to extremely severe, where intensive care is needed to prevent the loss of the calf.

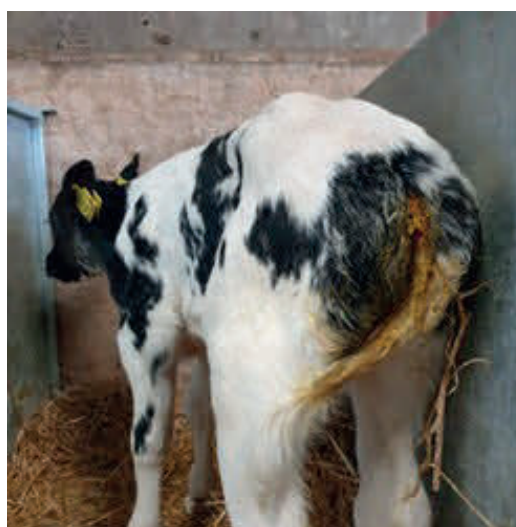
In all cases of scour, there are three main clinical problems;

1. Dehydration – the calf loses fluids and electrolytes (chemicals necessary for the proper function of the body systems)
2. Acidosis – all scouring calves experience a build-up of acid in the body
3. Loss of calories – the scouring calf will likely take less milk and won't be digesting that milk properly.

The first step in correcting these 3 issues is offering the calf an Oral Rehydration Solution, (ORS). This is commonly known as a scour sachet. These contain sodium, potassium and chloride to replace the lost electrolytes, buffers to neutralize the acid, and energy in the form of glucose. They are generally dissolved in 2 litres of water and are more effective than either water or milk in correcting the problems caused by neonatal diarrhoea. Nowadays, we continue to offer the milk feed as normal throughout the scour episode, as the calories, fats and protein are invaluable in maintaining body strength.

A calf that is scouring but still bright and drinking all its milk, may not appear to need an ORS but this is mistaken. A calf which has lost 5% (2 litres) of its body water will look completely normal from outward appearance but the 3 processes listed above will be starting to take their toll. Offering all scouring calves an ORS drink twice daily from the

first appearance of diarrhoea will help prevent the calf's condition deteriorating, hopefully keeping them bright and drinking milk, giving them the strength to recover.



Recent work has shown that an ORS with a high level of energy will help provide the calories necessary to support the calf's immune system and aid the repair of the damaged gut cells. Calves which are given a higher-calorie ORS will lose less weight and recover more quickly.

Most of the ORS products on the market contain only moderate energy levels, as they are based on older theories of calf rehydration.

Hydrafast has the highest energy levels of any ORS on the market and will best support the calf's metabolism during recovery, while also achieving optimum rehydration and acid-buffering. It is fed as a separate 2 litre feed twice daily, at least 2 hours after the milk feed has been offered.

Cattle Services News

I am pleased to announce recent updates regarding company activities along with some personnel changes.

Sales remained consistent throughout the Summer and Autumn, with optimism regarding several of our newest additions. Swaites Deer Hunter has maintained strong popularity, while Ravenhill Revolver continues to generate repeat orders. Following the August proof run, Hunnington Fantasy has demonstrated promising sales performance, as satisfied customers have placed additional orders.

A substantial export order for conventional units of Cuthill Towers Rhino was fulfilled for South Africa in September. Efforts to strengthen this partnership are ongoing, with the aim of securing additional orders in 2026. Shipments to Australia and New Zealand were successfully completed in mid-summer.

At the end of August, we were disappointed to learn that Sam Wake was leaving the company to advance his career within the industry. Duncan Hunter assumed the role on an interim basis to assist us in evaluating and restructuring the position for enhanced efficiency and long-term sustainability. Duncan has been subsequently asked to continue in this role on a part time basis.

Claire Hunter resigned as a company director because of her work commitments, but she remains involved in an advisory role. The company will consider appointing a replacement in 2026.

The young bull CS Ayr Punchline (Hawaiian x Sandyford Real Punchy) successfully entered Cogent, completed his quarantine period and is now beginning to produce product, but not yet mature enough for sexed units. Another new entrant, Tontine Cromwell (Hunter x Tontine Ideo Wellcome) has also entered the Cogent stud and will now begin his quarantine period.

The company continues to face cash flow challenges because of large investments in our product and delayed sales income caused by late payments. Although we've made good progress reducing overdue accounts, some debts remain unpaid, which we plan to pursue more assertively.

We recently marked the 60th anniversary of CSA, which we are celebrating with a 60-day promotion featuring several bulls. Each week, a "Sire of the Week" will be announced, offering bespoke discounted rates

in addition to a prize draw for any orders of 60 units or more. 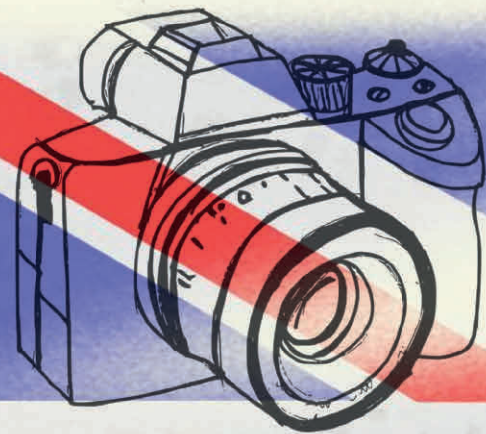

Reduction Sale from Middle Ayrshires and Red and Whites

The Whiteford family from Middle Farm near Brampton sold an outstanding group of cows in their reduction sale at Borderway Mart through Harrison & Hetherington. The uniformity and consistency from lot 1 to the final heifer was remarkable with exceptional rumps and strong toplines, the strength of the feet and legs was at a high level, and the quality of the udders was amazing.

Buyers from across the UK packed the ringside and observed on MartEye to watch a new Ayrshire breed record price take place at 15,000gns with the overall average for cows and heifers coming to £2825 with almost 50% selling for £3000 or more.

Middle Jean KM 2 EX92 sold for 15,000gns setting the new Ayrshire breed record taking over the previous 2019 record that was set by Sandyford Famed Clover who sold for 13,000gns. **Middle Jean KM 2** is sired by Whiteflat King Marty who is a son of Changue Martha EX95 who was a three-time UK Dairy Expo Champion. This special young cow was

classified EX92 in her third lactation, just one point from a maximum score and was purchased by the Bryson family from Whiteflat farm in Ayrshire.

In total, 82 heifers in milk sold, with two topping at 4,500gns. The first was for **Middle Elkin KM 6**, a daughter of Whiteflat King Marty with a world class mammary who recently calved at the end of August and displayed potential to develop into a special show heifer. She was bought by Adam Lindsay from Gretna.

The second heifer to sell for 4,500gns was **Middle Mae ME VG86** 2yr who was bought by Mr Tinker from Yorkshire. This powerful framed heifer was sired by Moathouse Mighty Eagle and was only a few weeks fresh and again displayed outstanding show potential.

The daughters of Moathouse Mighty Eagle impressed with **Middle Mitzy MME 2 VG86 2 yr** selling for 4,400gns to the Danforth family from Yorkshire.

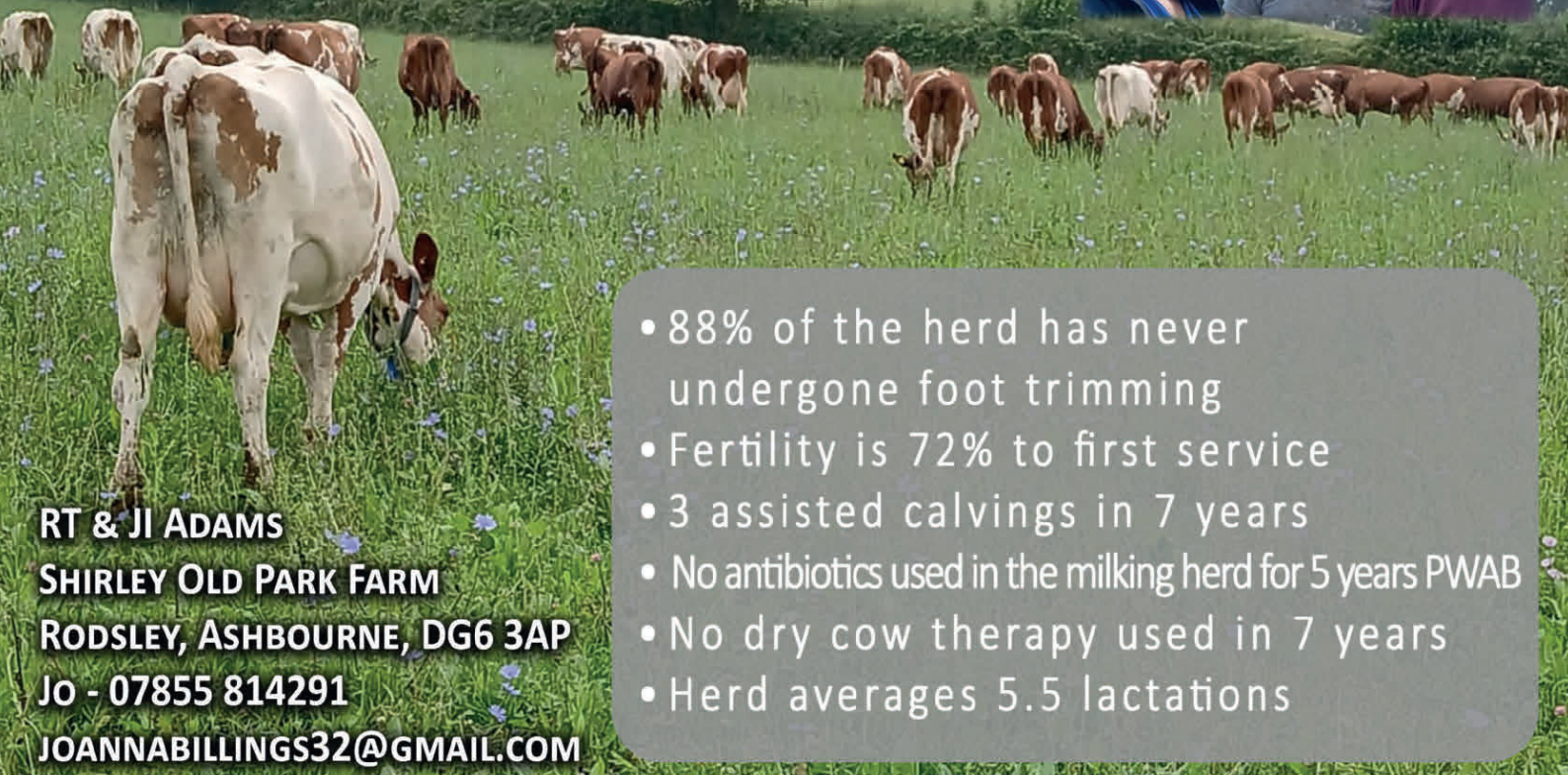

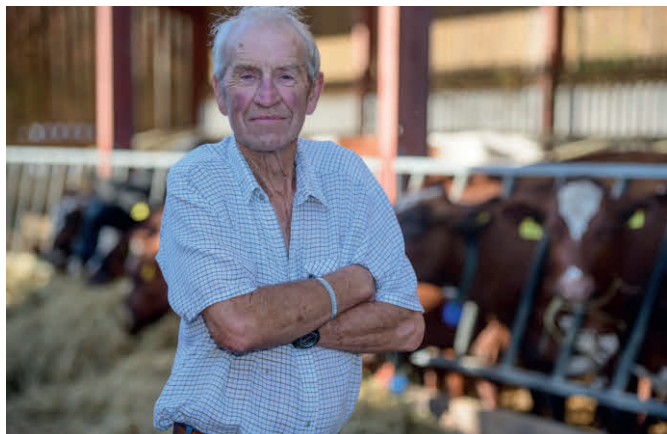

Margins over yield: Secret to success for Ayrshire herd



Mike Windel farms his 200-head Ayrshire herd at Whitehouse Farm, on the outskirts of Swindon.

After starting out on a Wiltshire County Council small holding tenancy in 1972, Mike Windel and his wife Rosmary have proved passion pays off with their pedigree Ayrshire herd.

The Windel family have always milked Ayrshire cattle, and after starting out 57 years ago have grown the herd from 60 cows to just over 200.

Mike and Rosemary Windel have built up the system from a modest farm set up at Whitehouse Farm, on the outskirts of Swindon, alongside his son, Russell, full-time worker, Ryan and a relief milker. Alongside the dairy herd, the family run a contracting and straw business.

It is clear to see Mike's life revolves around the well-being of his cows and he takes great pride in turning them out, which can be seen in the showring, especially when he claimed the overall championship at the Dairy Show, held at the Bath and West Showground in October 2024.

Legacy

The family have always kept the Ayrshire breed, with Mike's father and uncle keeping them before him.

Originally the farm was 23 hectares (59 acres) but they have grown the system, now owning 54 hectares (132 acres) and renting a further 36 hectares (89 acres) in the locality.

The majority of the farm is in a six-year grassland rotation, with the exception of 5% which is planted in flowers which is required for their milk contract with Waitrose. Another 32 hectares (80 acres) is planted in arable crops of wheat, which is used to provide feed and wholecrop for the herd, alongside straw which is sourced from their hay and straw supplying business, which is headed up by Russell.

Over the years, a focus has been put on creating an environment which will increase cow comfort while allowing the herds expansion. This has proved especially needed over the past 12 months, with the herd being down with bovine TB for the first time since its establishment. This has seen cow numbers rise from 160 to 200 and keeping an extra 30 heifers. This has resulted in the Windel's putting more heifers to beef sires than usual, and housing 115 British Blue store cattle, which they sell at Cirencester market around 12 months old.

"We usually keep them slightly longer, but due to the extra headage we sold our first batch in July selling to 385p/kg at £1,500," says Mike.

As an all-year-round calving herd, great attention to detail is put into breeding considerations, with the family carefully considering every cows mating choice.

Mike says: "For the past 25 years we have been a closed herd, so selecting sires is important to getting new blood into the herd. We look for a traditional Ayrshire type, using mainly sexed semen. Selection is made for traits providing longevity as well as fats and protein in mind, that is what we get paid on, we can get milk out of them, but we need that aspect too.

"We look at their back pedigree performance and their lifetime achievements, then look at the bulls qualities to strike a balance. Some of the sires we are fond of are West Mossgiel Modern Reality, Ardmore Crown Napier, Plaskett Bruno, Rosehill Vitality and Brierside Magic." An Aberdeen-Angus sweeper bull is also used following the service period.

Family Lines

The Wroughton female lines run over three main families; Alice, Nina and Mayflower.

Mike says: "Alice is an especially noted line, going back to Wroughton Alice who produced 128 tonne lifetime yield, which was a world record for a pure Ayrshire cow at the time.

Russell has spent many years transforming the existing yard of a haybarn, and parlour shed, fabricating sheds, cubicles, gates and laying concrete to host the expanded herd.

Five years ago, the farm replaced its 12:12 herringbone parlour, updating to a 16:32 Fullwood parlour which the cows are milked through twice a day.

"We focus on margins over yield, and are averaging £2,200 per cow," says Mike.

"This is one of the reasons we love having Ayrshires on the farm. We admire their longevity, great legs and feet and their grazing ability meaning we can stock them tighter. They are also a lovely cow to look at."

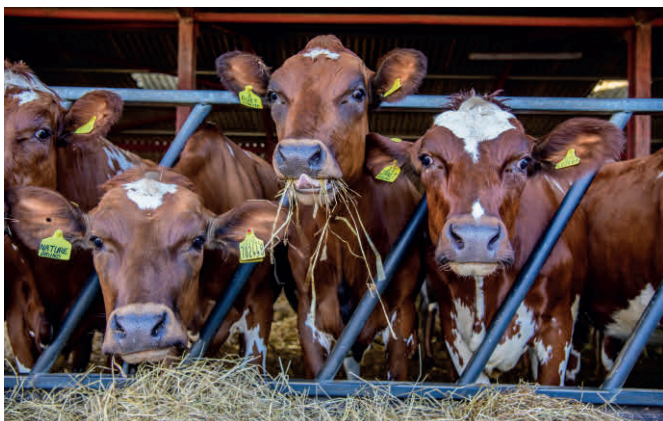

The herd produced 1.3 million litres, averaging 8,000 litres per cow, with the best cow this lactation delivering 54kg daily. Butterfat levels currently stand at 4.26%, protein at 3.38% with a cell count of 86.

Mr Windel says this is achieved through attention to detail in feeding.

Grassland is made up of herbal leys and ryegrass leys from April to November and are fed a total mixed ration in the winter that includes grass silage and a 22% blend.

"We work closely with our nutritionist and aim to keep optimum consistency in the diet. A ration of rolled wheat and grass silage from second and third cuts.



Dry cows are on a ration of grass silage, barley straw and pre-calving rolls.

"In the parlour, 4kg of concentrates is fed per cow and then outside an allotted allocation is fed according to the cows needs through an out of parlour feeder," adds Mike.

The dry cows are on a ration of grass silage, barley straw and pre-calving rolls. Nearer to calving date, they are moved onto 10kg of the milk cow ration plus ad-lib barley straw which sees the herd have no issues with milk fever or displaced stomachs.

Calves are reared on milk powder and ad-lib course mix until they are weaned at between eight and 12 weeks before they are then moved onto an 18% concentrate with ad-lib straw.

At five months they move onto silage, chopped straw and concentrate up to being turned out once they are in calf.

Passion

The Windel's passion for the breed sees them want to give back to the breed.

Last year, they invited Ayrshire breeders from across the world to Whitehouse Farm, as part of the World Ayrshire Conference.

This is also the case in the showring, which Mike says gives him one of the greatest senses of achievement.

"Presenting good, home-bred stock to the public and other farmers gives me great pride and always has done. We can display the best of our herd off the farm," he says.

"One of our favourite shows is the Dairy Show, held every October."

They are pleased to have had much success at the show over the years, including last when they claimed the champion Ayrshire title.

The winner, Wroughton Mayflower 2, is an EX92 classified cow is sired by Wroughton Lord Winston. The family are hoping to attend the show as usual this year.

"Dairy farming has always given me the greatest joy however I cannot help but notice its changes over the past 70 years. So much more time is demanded in the office than practically farming, which takes its toll on so many.

"My passion for the cattle has only strengthened and I will milk until I can no longer walk and show until I can no longer enter the ring," says Mike.
