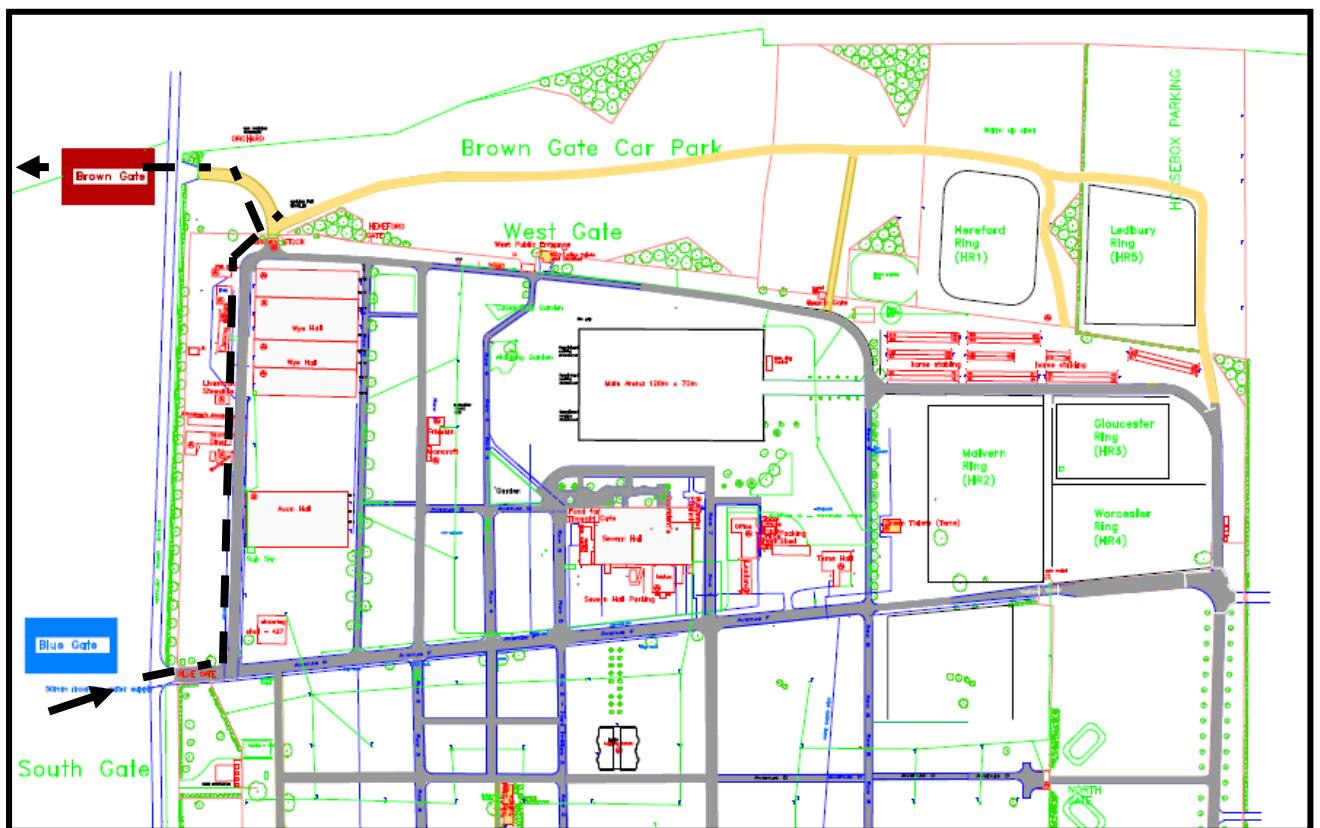

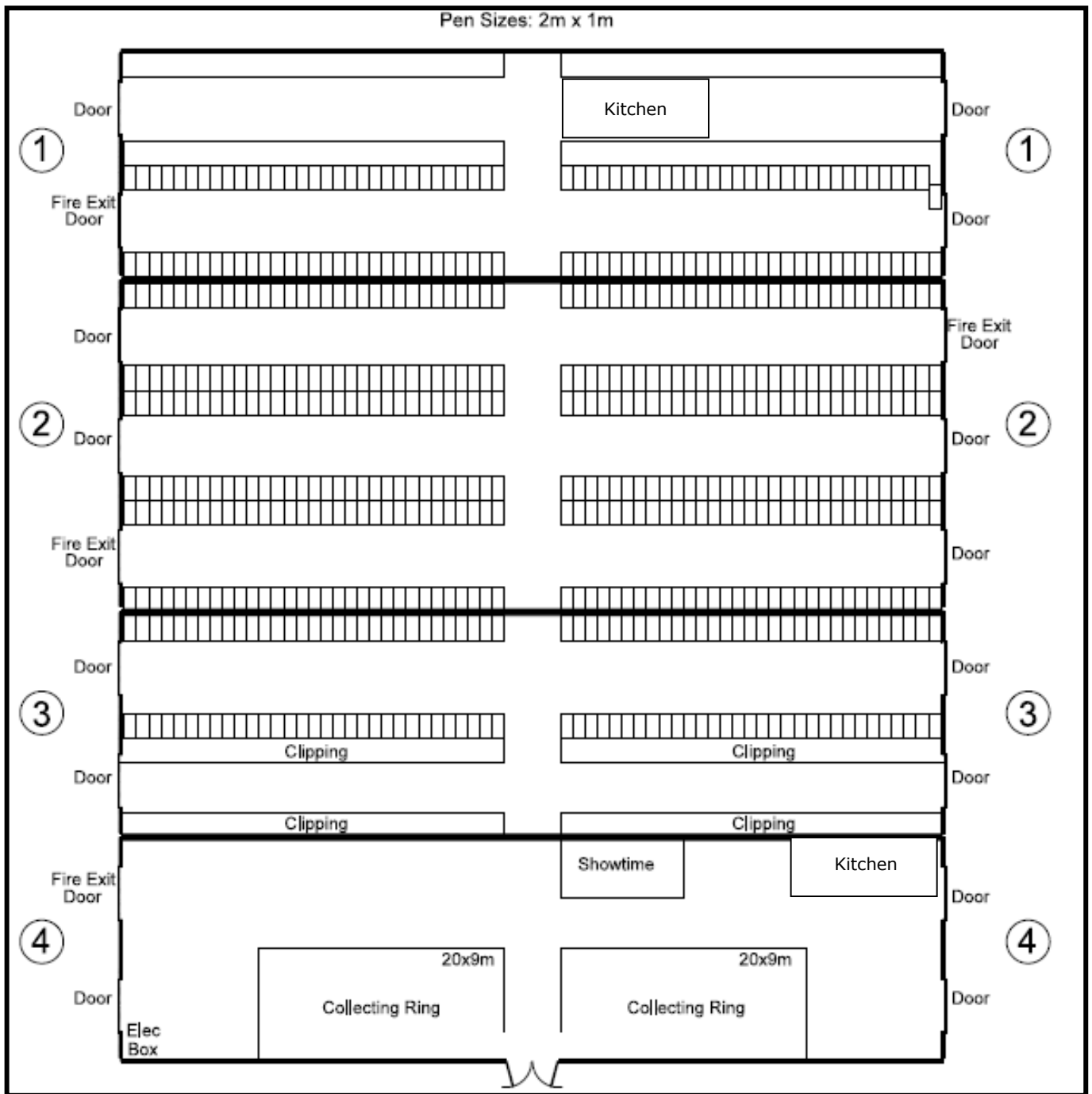
The Main Show Ring will be in the Avon Hall for all Classes. The collection rings are located in Bay 4 of the Wye Hall.

Due to DEFRA and Showground regulations, muck must not be put onto second row. **Strictly no parking on second row.** All livestock vehicles must be washed out after unloading in the lorry wash and be parked in the Brown Gate Car park.

## **IMPORTANT INFORMATION**

Entries fees are £5.00 + VAT per animal. Fees are required on entry and should be payable to the relevant breed society.

The correct Pedigree certificate and Passport must accompany all animals.

All animals attending the event **MUST** be accompanied by a pre-movement TB test certificated regardless of the location of the holding they are travelling from. Paper work **MUST** accompany the animals and be presented to the Show Officials.

All calves showing signs of Ringworm must have a veterinary certificate showing that they have been treated for at least two weeks before the show, and the lesions must be inactive and have hair growing on them.

Only the competitors may lead the calves in the showmanship and calf classes, no assistance will be allowed.

In the calf classes, calves may be handled by anyone 26 or under on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2014. For the mature classes, Classes 27 to 34, calves may be handled by anyone 30 or under on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2014.

Each breed will be shown under their own Society rules.

A calf **MAY NOT** be shown in more than one handler class.

All competitors are required to wear the appropriate Society's showing uniform. Entry will be refused if competitors are not wearing the correct uniform.

Show Officials have the right to refuse entry to any competitors who are late for their class.

Once at the show any clipping or preparation of calves must only be done by the owner or a member aged 26 and under.

Clippers, hairdryers, kettles and other electrical appliances must comply with electrical standards (PAT tested) and will be subject to testing if appropriate.

No animal previously or currently owned or bred by the judge as stated in the schedule will be allowed to be shown.

No substitutes or late entries will be permitted.

**The Show Committee cannot accept any liability for loss or damage to property, person or livestock. It is the responsibility of each individual to ensure that adequate insurance cover security measures are taken.**

The Show Committee expects all competitors to behave in a responsible and appropriate way throughout the weekend's events. Individuals are expected to represent their breed to the best of their ability.

Over 18's will require proof of identification.

No alcohol will be allowed in the cattle lines for the duration of the event, stewards reserve the right to confiscate any alcohol found.

Any person found causing damage to property or persons will be immediately banned from taking part in the event and will be made to pay for any damages.

Anyone under 18 will require a Parental Consent form, which **MUST** be signed and returned with the entry forms.

## **SHOWING RULES AND REGULATIONS**

### **ENTRIES**

Entries are restricted to three per class per exhibitor. The show management reserve the right to limit the numbers of entries each exhibitor may bring to the show should the number of entries exceed the number of calves that can be stalled. No substitute or late entries will be accepted.

### **CLOSING DATE**

The closing date for entries is **MONDAY 6<sup>th</sup> OCTOBER 2014**. Please return entries to the relevant Breed Society. No late entries will be accepted.

### **ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURES**

Registration certificates and passports **MUST** be brought to the event and will be checked by the stewards.

All calves **MUST** arrive on site by 22 00hrs on Friday. Late arrivals will not be permitted. Departure time will be from approximately 1530hrs on Sunday directly after the final presentations.

### **TIDY LINES & BEST PROMOTIONAL STAND**

A trophy, presented by RABDF, will be awarded to the Individual Competitor or Group of Competitors (*when showing as a team*), whose stand best promotes the herd, breed and club and gives the best impression to visitors of tidiness, teamwork, promotion and of organisation.

### **DICK STAPLETON AWARD**

A trophy, presented by Dick Stapleton, will be awarded to the individual who in the opinion of the show committee helped others to the best of their ability throughout the duration of the show.

### **VENUE AND PROVISIONS**

One bale of straw will be provided free of charge for each stall booked. Shavings and additional straw can be brought to the event but will not be available for purchase.

### **LIABILITY**

Holstein UK cannot accept any liability for loss or damage to property, person or livestock. It is the responsibility of each individual to ensure that adequate insurance cover and security measures are taken. No lorries or cattle trailers are permitted to park in the cattle sheds due to fire regulations.

### **CLIPPING & PREPARATION**

Once at the show any clipping or preparation of calves must be done by an HYB member aged 26 or under from their **OWN** club. Any competitors or persons assisting in the preparation of the calf from a different club will lead to disqualification.

### **ELECTRICAL/COOKING EQUIPMENT**

Health and safety regulations do not allow the use of any electrical or cooking equipment in the cattle lines. Kettles may be used but not urns, they **MUST** be placed on a solid surface and cables **MUST** not create a trip hazard. This will be strictly adhered to. A communal kitchen area will be provided in bay 1 and bay 4. We ask everybody to make use of these communal areas that have been provided.

All electrical equipment **MUST** be PAT tested and in line with IEE regulations, paragraph 7.6.2.

### **FAKING**

Any faking that is seen to take place, either by the competitors or persons assisting in the preparation of the calf, will lead to disqualification from the competition. Doping of calves at the final is also **NOT** permitted and any person seen doing so, or suspected of doing so, will be disqualified. Any injection to an animal must be reported to the chief steward prior to administration. False hair in toplines is not permitted.

## **BOVINE TUBERCULOSIS REGULATIONS**

**Show organisers require ALL EXHIBITORS attending the show to pre movement test exhibition animals. All exhibitors are required to supply a copy of their TB Certificate to the Show Office PRIOR to arrival at the venue. Copies accepted by post, fax and email.**

All cattle going to be housed at a show OR going to a Show that takes place for a period of over 24 hours must be pre-movement tested if they are from a High Risk Area.

The Pre-movement test is valid for 60 days from the date of Injection NOT the date of reading. Only the animals attending the Cattle Shows need to be Pre-movement tested.

The AHVLA and BCMS will be doing a random 10% check on all cattle attending all Shows. If a pre-movement test has not been carried out then a Post-Movement test will be required.

### **Regulations for Scottish Exhibitors**

2007 Regulations: Post-movement testing. Any bovine animal on any premises in Scotland which has been moved from a premise in a high incidence area shall have a diagnostic test for tuberculosis applied to it no fewer than 60 days and no more than 120 days after the date on which it first arrives at premises in Scotland. Please note that the Telford International Centre is in a high risk area, therefore it is recommended that a post movement test is carried out. However the centre is not in contact with any cattle bar those coming to UK Dairy Day, which will have been tested TB free.

### **Regulations for Welsh Exhibitors**

All cattle coming from Wales must be pre-movement tested.
