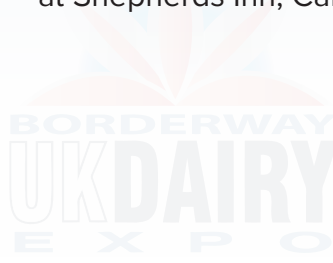

HOLSTEIN, SHORTHORN & BROWN SWISS **YAN JACOBS, Quebec, Canada**

Yan Jacobs is from Cap-Santé, Quebec Canada and was born and raised on Jacobs Farm. He now owns this farm along with his father Jean Jacobs and his sister Ysabel Jacobs.

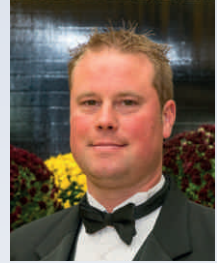
Jacobs Farm is now milking 215 cows and the herd has 60 EX, 145 VG & 42 GP and the herd average is 11,000 kg, 4.4 F, 3.24 P.

Nowadays Jacobs Farm has been eight times Premier Breeder at World Dairy Expo in Madison and eight times at Royal Winter Fair in Toronto. They also have bred and owned 94 All-Canadian nominations and 60 All-American nominations.

To date Yan's judging career has taken him in a few countries around the world. Last year he judged the Utah Show and the Wisconsin Spring Show. He has judged numerous county shows in Quebec, in the past few years. In 2016 Yan Jacobs was the associate judge at World Dairy Expo in Madison.

When is he not working at the farm, he also has a full-time job raising his five marvellous children.

We welcome Yan Jacobs to the Borderway UK Dairy Expo as this will be the first time he has judged outside North America.



UK & INTERNATIONAL SHOWMANSHIP CHAMPIONSHIPS **AMY MILLER, UK**

Amy is from the home of Shanael Holstein's where her father Michael and two brothers Paul and Steven run a 600-cow dairy herd. When Amy is not busy teaching the next generation how to catch a ball she is helping at home.

Through Holstein Young Breeders, Amy has been lucky to win trips to Canada representing the UK at the Gencor Challenge and was a member of the Walk of Fame Team at the Royal Winter Fair.

Her proudest memories of showing would be when Shanael Leader Marie won the National Holstein Show and being part of the Rapid Bay team at the Royal Winter Fair when Vandenberg Amedeo Gorgeous won Supreme Champion.

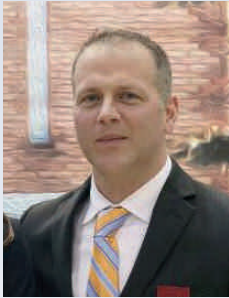
Amy has judged at numerous shows and is looking forward to judging the International Showmanship Competition at the UK Dairy Expo 2020.

PAT CONROY, Angola, Indiana

Pat Conroy lives in Angola, Indiana with his wife, Jeannie, and their children, Kaiden (13) and Zailey (9). Pat markets high-end type and commercial cattle, both domestically and internationally.



He is also co-owner of Genesis Genetics Mexico. Pat owns 60-90 registered Holsteins and Jerseys scattered throughout the United States and several countries along with a small registered herd of Angus owned in partnership.

Pat Conroy has owned or sold numerous All-American and All-Canadian Nominees, many of which have been recognized as Champion, Reserve or Honourable Mention at World Dairy Expo and the Royal Agricultural Winter Fair as well as having 5 cows nominated for the All-World competition.

Pat has judged or fitted cattle in 19 different countries throughout his career. Some of the most notable shows he has judged include the 2018 International Jersey Show, the 2016 International Holstein Show, the 2015 International Red & White Show, the 2013 International Junior Holstein Show and the 2016 European National and Swiss Expo Shows.

BRITISH FRIESIAN NATIONAL SHOW

BRIAN MILLER, SOMERSET, UK

Brian is part of a family partnership that farms 450 acres in Somerset. They milk 240 Holsteins and 20 Brown Swiss cows averaging 10,500kg 4.2% on 2 times milking and with 90 EX's in the herd under the famous Moorshard prefix.

After completing an Agricultural Economics degree from Reading University, and since leaving University he has taken responsibility for managing the cows at Moorshard alongside his father and grandmother. The herd has been 6 times finalists in Holstein UK herd competition and showing has been regularly undertaken at National and Regional level.



Highlights from the show ring within the herd includes Moorshard Lennon Rosa 93 winning Dairy Show Championship, becoming Reserve All Britain 2nd calver in 2013 and also seeing Richard Thomas' family winning The Dairy Show and Welsh Dairy Shows with Moorshard Dude Parade which he purchased at the Genetic Elite Sale in 2014.

Brian's judging career has taken him all over the UK and into the Republic of Ireland on several occasions. Within the UK he has officiated at a number of county and regional shows as well as the 2010 National Dairy Event, 2016 All Breed All Britain calf show, was the Holstein judge at the 2017 UK Dairy Day and last year judged the 2018 Great Yorkshire Show.

UK Dairy Industry Honours Industry Star at UK Dairy Expo 2020

The John Dennison Lifetime Achievement Award will be presented at the Borderway UK Dairy Expo for the eighth year running. This award is in memory of the life time industry contribution made by Cumbrian dairy farmer and highly regarded breeder John Dennison.

The aim of this award is to recognise the dairy cattle breeder or exhibitor judged to be a high achiever and exemplary role model within the dairy industry.



Winner of the 2019 award was Bill Nadin from the Sterndale herd in Derbyshire. Always looking to improve the herd Bill travelled to Canada and United States in the late 1980's early 90's to source new cow families, flying back to the UK numerous animals to start families such as the Fawn's, Gloria's, Barbs to name only a few also investing in the UK with his purchases like the Ghost's and Ashlyn's.

He has bred some outstanding bulls as well such as Sterndale Rose Royce Red which Semex Sterndale Affection from the Ashlyn.

Alongside his partner Yasmin the Sterndale herd has also had many success in the show ring at all levels winning local, regional and national shows with cows like Rae, Ghost and Erle to name but a few over the years.

In 2013 the Sterndale herd won the coveted Premier Herd title followed by yet another amazing sale and only last year the Sterndale herd was entered into the Holstein International most Influential Breeder of the last 25 years competition.

This unique award is given to the nominee judged to have the perfect combination of ability, sportsmanship, integrity and character within the Dairy Industry. The winner will be announced and presented with their award at the Borderway UK Dairy Expo on 14th March.

Glyn Lucas at Harrison and Hetherington said: "This award really is a unique award for UK Dairy Industry. It recognises people who shine and who have put their lifetimes work into the industry, just like all the previous winners".

ANIMAL WELFARE

It is the responsibility of each exhibitor for the welfare of the animals entered for competition in the Borderway UK Dairy Expo classes. If, in the opinion of the Official Stewards and/or Official Veterinary Surgeon, any animal is mistreated, or presented for judging in anything other than an approved state, then that exhibitor will be barred from presenting any of his animals for judging, and all prize money will be withheld.

If any animal requires hypodermic injection or artificial stimulant for any reason whatsoever the veterinary officer or failing, the chief steward must be informed before the action takes place and must be witness to the action.

Any exhibitor or his representative found to be using methods which could be construed as malpractice will, along with his animals, be removed from the show site immediately, and all prize money withheld. Exhibitors in any doubt about what constitutes malpractice should consult the Official Stewards. All animals may be subject to tests and exhibitors may be asked to present a veterinary certificate.

The Stewards appointed by the Borderway UK Dairy Expo will be doing all they can to ensure the well-being of exhibitors and animals, and ask for the co-operation of exhibitors.

1. Registration

All breeds will be exhibited under their Breed Society Conditions. All dairy cattle must be registered in the Herd Book or be in the grading-up appendices to the Herd Book of the appropriate Breed Society.

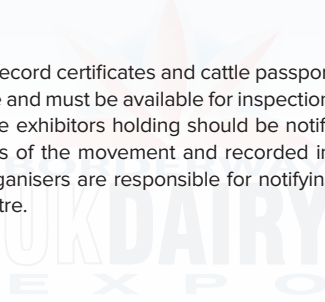
Animals registered as ASR (SRA) under the Holstein Herd Book are not eligible.

Animals entered in the Ayrshire classes must be at least 51% Ayrshire blood/genetics and be registered with the Ayrshire Cattle Society in appendix B, A or Pedigree sections, any Black and White animals to be fully pedigree Ayrshire.

All animals for the Red & White classes must be Red & White in colour. Animals with a questionable hair coat colour will be referred to a representative of the UK Dairy Expo.

2. Records

Identification registrations, milk record certificates and cattle passports must accompany the animals to the Borderway Centre and must be available for inspection by the stewards at any time. Movement off and onto the exhibitors holding should be notified to the British Cattle Movement Service within 3 days of the movement and recorded in the holding of origins movement books. The show organisers are responsible for notifying BCMS of movements onto and off the Borderway Centre.



3. Biosecurity

Exhibitors are required under legislation to cleanse and disinfect transport vehicles that have carried stock as soon as possible and in any case within 24 hours. Robust footwear should be worn which is capable of being disinfected at the show.

4. Arrival of Cattle

Dairy cattle will only be admitted to the Borderway Centre between –

12noon and 6.00pm

Thursday 12th March

7.00am and 9.00am

Friday 13th March

5. Departure of Cattle

Cattle will be permitted to leave the Borderway Centre at the close of the Borderway UK Dairy Expo - from 5.30pm until 8pm on Saturday 14th March. All cattle must be removed by 10am on Sunday 15th March. Any movement outwith these hours can only be made with the approval of the Organisers. Prize money will be withheld if these conditions are not met.

6. Veterinary Inspection/Services

All cattle will be subject to veterinary inspection on entering and at any time in the Borderway Centre, if requested by the Veterinary Surgeon or Chief Steward. Any veterinary services will be paid for by the exhibitor.

7. Stalling

Exhibitors will be permitted to use their stall space for the presentation of information and publicity material relating to the animals present or herd represented, but may not in any circumstances advertise on behalf of a third party. Under no circumstances should the stalling be dismantled or altered in any way.

8. Straw

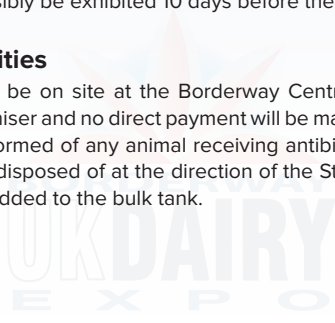
A limited amount of straw will be provided, additional straw may be purchased.

9. Head Boards

Only official headboards supplied with completed information from the Organisers may be used. All stock exhibitors must have readily available on arrival at the Borderway Centre official milk record information. Exhibitors must return the requested information on all animals that will possibly be exhibited 10 days before the event.

10. Milking Facilities

Milking facilities will be on site at the Borderway Centre. Milk produced becomes the property of the Organiser and no direct payment will be made to exhibitors. The Organisers Steward must be informed of any animal receiving antibiotic treatment, and all milk from that animal must be disposed of at the direction of the Steward. Under no circumstances should that milk be added to the bulk tank.



11. Electrical Equipment

It is a condition of entry that all exhibitors should provide and use circuit breakers with all electrical equipment.

All electrical equipment - no matter how small - must have a current PAT (Portable Appliance Test) Certificate. These certificates must be available for inspection on the day prior to the Borderway UK Dairy Expo; they may also be required for inspection by the City of Carlisle Council officials.

12. Entries and Entry Fees

Exhibitors are solely responsible for the accuracy and eligibility of their entries, which must be accompanied by the appropriate payment.

Exhibitors must abide by the Rules and Regulations of the Borderway UK Dairy Show, and must also observe the Rules of the appropriate Breed Society.

The entry fee is £50 + VAT per milking entry and £30 + VAT per dry stock/calves. All entry forms must be accompanied by payments and must be received by Monday 3rd February 2020. Only in exceptional circumstances will entry fees be refunded.

13. Interpretation of Rules

The decision of the Organisers and Chief Steward are in all matters final. The Organiser reserves the right to refuse entries or to reject any animal. Exhibitors must abide by the Rules and Regulations of the Borderway UK Dairy Expo.
